 - Used to cover carnival tents
 - Rental for \$100 a tent

 - We will be down to \$3,000 after current approved requisitions
 - Can we rent the tents?
 - Are there tent toppers?
 - Can we use the budget to cover the cost of renting?
 - Would need a requisition.
 - Why can't we use the \$56,000 that the account says we have?
 - There is a budget that outlines where all money goes.
 - We also have to start the year with money in the account.
 - Could we borrow tents from families?
 - Committee is looking for a uniform look.
