Committee Chair Reports

• <u>Step It Up – Cara Walsh-Meaker</u>

- We stepped it up!!!! Raised: \$29,688
- Day of Awesomeness: Tuesday, October 18th, 2022 730am-1030.
 - If you are interested in volunteering, on Tuesday, please show up.
 - Check in to the office with Mary 1st, get a sticker, then head out to the softball/baseball field. We just need volunteers at each blow-up to help staff the craziness.
- Reflections on this year's fundraiser.
 - We have been doing Step It Up since 2019. It is a great fundraiser and has raised more money than any of our previous Fall fundraisers in the past.
 - Last year we raised \$31K. We were hoping to raise the same or more. We raised \$29,688 this year. We were really hoping to make it to \$30K.
 - Here is some of the analysis, which we are going to look deeper into.
 - We had a higher rate of participation. 79.5% Which is extraordinary!
 - There was a group of students to sent 10 emails or more, and raised \$0.
 - It's hard to send out 10 emails and get no donations. We want to look into further to see if perhaps it was just purposeful; to get the golden ticket.
 - The prizes weren't as great this year, so maybe kids weren't as motivated to participate and raise as much money?
 - Maybe kids more kids have siblings entering the school this year or are at KMS and have to split the money between here and there?
 - What was the median donation? Did it differ greatly between grades?
 - Our top earner this year was a Kindergartener!
 - Complaint from participant: they keep increasing the goal without your consent.

• Recommend keeping this fundraiser.

- We have done Step It Up for the past 4 years. It raised all the money we need for the school year. It is very simple and easy for us to manage. What we did for the fundraisers before this required a lot more volunteers/staff and only raised half the money.
 - 2019 75% participation, raised just over \$30K
 - 2020 50% participation, raised \$27K
 - 2021 76% participation, raised just over \$31K
 - 2022 79.5% participation, raised almost \$30K
- In 2019 we had 544 students, and we are now down to 448 students. We dropped almost 100 students and are still raising a similar amount of money.
- Time it well in our community. We had this before KMS had their fundraiser.

Trunk or Treat – FRIDAY, OCTOBER 25TH 5:30pm-7:30pm – Susan Fishman

- If you are new to Waggoner, Trunk or Treat is a night of fun where we ask parents, teachers, whoever to decorate a trunk and hand out candy. You provide the trunk, we'll provide the candy!!! Nothing too scary; no gore.
- We used to have 1 trunk per class, but we opened it up to whoever wants to do one. Last year we did this and had a record number of trunks; 26 trunks.

- We're switching up the schedule this year. We're bringing back the *Parade*. The kids will start with the parade and then go into the *Thriller Dance* with Mrs. Weisberg. Then we'll open it up to the trunk or treating and a couple of other activities:
 - Scavenger Hunt and the Witches Layer.

School Garden

- A few weeks ago we visited Mirada Elementary. They have 3 school gardens!!! So we really want to do a secret garden here with with gnomes and a calming corner for students and staff.
- \circ $\,$ Cara and Susan recommended checking out the kindergarten courtyard.
- We did an outside learning space for the older kids, so this would be a great place for the younger kids. It's also a great place for the the 2nd graders to release their butterflies.
- Planning.
 - It's 1500 square feet. It's not going to be expensive and like in the grand scheme of things, the other outdoor spaces were 6000 square feet to renovate. I think it'll be a really nice place for students to go. It's small, so the kindergarten teachers can go out with the kids and it isn't like they're run off.
 - Stacey Clarken, Mrs. Romero, and I met with Todd Nakagawa on the 24th to determine what we could do. The area needs to be graded. We plan on doing partial turf. We want to do it well, but keep it on the cheap; So keep it simple and have room for decorations. The 5th grade permanent art project can go there. We need painted rocks to go around the tree. We can do legacy tiles in there. We're going to have a couple raised garden beds. Kelly Robb is on board for maintaining and has a lot of ideas for a raised bed garden so the 2nd graders have a place to go when they do their insect unit.
 - Todd sent us the renderings today. I'm going to send them out to the committee. We
 need to get approved by our groundskeeper. Mrs. Romero reached out to the district
 about the turf and the locks. We want to see what else can the district help with.
- We just need to figure out financing and how we are going to pay for it. I'm hoping to meet with the committee between now and the November meeting, so I can present a plan and estimate at the November PTO meeting. I feel like if we have a plan and timeline, we will get momentum to get this taken care of.

Newsletter Feedback

- We shifted from weekly emails to once a month emails.
 - Is this good for you?
- I'm still sending out blasts a day or so before the events.
- Feedback:
 - The sign-ups should be sent out sooner.
 - Maybe a monthly flyer?
