 - Cash Profit for PTO: \$2,946.40
 - 101 books purchased for teachers by families!!!
 - We made over \$300 via 'rounding up'
- Switch Vendors for next year; looking into
 - Books are sold at a reduced rate, which may affect our profit. Hopefully it will allow more families to afford a book or two. And those that usually buy books, will likely spend the same amount of money, but get more books.
 - The company rounds pricing; if the book says \$4, it's \$4 and includes the tax already.
 - That will affect our 'all for books' change ('round up'). So I'll have to get creative
 to come up with another way to encourage the kids & Waggoner community to
 get excited about donating books to the library.
