- Highlights:
  - Deposited \$778 cash from Glow Dance.
  - o Deposited \$160 from Chanson video fundraiser.
  - o Paid \$1500 to Nerding (split with Site Council)
  - Paid Trunk or Treat permit expense (\$150) brings total TorT expense to \$511
- Overall: spent \$1,755 this month.
  - o For the year, we've brought in more than we've spent.
